5th / 6th Give thanks for the opportunity staff had last month to attend disability training at the Walkabout Foundation. Give thanks for our good relationship with them and our shared mission to reach children with disabilities to improve their wellbeing. Give thanks for the staff's willingness to learn and pray they would put their new skills and knowledge into practice and their work will bring dignity, inclusion, and hope to the children they serve.

7th / 8th Pray for a boy who comes to the Saturday Club and seems quite withdrawn and absent minded but has not been able to share any personal issue. Pray God would draw near to him and help him overcome the struggles he has to express himself. Pray that if there are personal issues or trauma, he would gain confidence and trust to share those with staff or others who could help. Pray for wisdom, patience, and compassion for those leading the Club. May every conversation and activity point him, and others, to Jesus.

9th / 10th Four caregivers recently completed the Basic Business Training. Give thanks for the knowledge, confidence, and encouragement they have gained through the course. Pray for one of them who has already started her new business, that God would bless her work, guide her decisions, and help her business to grow and succeed. Also pray for the other caregivers, that they will have patience and perseverance as they continue saving towards their start-up costs.

11th / 12th Give thanks for the opportunity we have each week to reach out to men at the Men's Table Talk. Pray for Stephen as he starts the topic of mental health. Pray for a strong attendance and meaningful engagement. Pray that God would bring peace to troubled minds, strength to weary hearts, and hope to those carrying silent burdens.

13th / 14th Pray that God would open doors for us to share the good news of Jesus Christ with boldness, wisdom, and love. Pray that He would prepare hearts to receive His truth, and many lives would be transformed by His Spirit, bringing hope, repentance, and new life in Christ.

15th / 16th As the charity grows there is an increased need for volunteers to help support the work. Pray for willing and skilled volunteers to come forward, especially those able to help write grant applications. 23rd/24th Pray for the CY Christianity Explored course. Pray that the truth of the gospel will speak deeply to the hearts of the boys attending. Pray that their eyes would be opened to see who God is and they would have a desire to know Him personally.

25th/26th As the organisation grows, particularly the APT Kenya project, space in our current rented premises is becoming a concern. Please join us in prayer as we trust God for provision of a spacious, accessible, and central premises where all people can feel welcomed and supported.

27th/28th Give thanks for the staff who serve faithfully each day. Pray God would give them strength, wisdom, and encouragement in their work. Pray they will be filled with compassion, unity, and love as they support others
