The conference highlighted many of the challenges people living with disabilities face every day, including stigma, lack of opportunities, inaccessible buildings and transport, and poor implementation of disability laws. Staff were encouraged by meeting people with different disabilities, church leaders, advocates, and government representatives who spoke passionately about disability rights and inclusion.

As well as being spiritually refreshed, the team also had the opportunity to share with others about the work of Jabori Foundation, making valuable new connections that we pray will lead to positive opportunities for the families we serve.,

APRIL HOLIDAY CLUB

Our two-week Holiday Club in April was a truly blessed and successful time for the staff and children. Throughout the programme, between 160-200 children attended each day and took part in fun activities and meaningful discussions while also growing spiritually through daily Bible lessons.

We are especially grateful to the local community for their generous support of food donations which enabled us to provide the children with a meal each day. This made a real difference to many of the children who often go without meals during the school holidays when not accessing the school feeding programme. We sincerely thank everyone who contributed, volunteered, and supported the programme in any way.



STAFF TRAINING

Staff had the privilege of attending a week long disability training in May, hosted by the Walkabout Foundation. Walkabout Foundation is based in Nanyuki and provides wheelchairs, APT devices and therapy services to children with disabilities. The training aimed to strengthen skills in supporting children with developmental disabilities and their families. Key topics included disability inclusion, feeding and nutrition, play, communication, and caregiver wellbeing. The experience has strengthened our team's capacity to deliver inclusive, family-centred support through our caregiver training days and Disability Support Group meetings.
