The weekly Bible Study has continued throughout the year. We are grateful to Tony Were from Crosspoint Bible Church for leading the studies.



In November, 8 caregivers attended Basic Business Skills training in preparation to start their own business.



Over 50 boys aged between 11-16yrs have attended the Saturday Club this year. All made an APT stool which they took home.



This year the team have provided over 240 postural support devices to children with disabilities from all over Kenya.



## NEW APT Partnership

We are thrilled to announce our partnership with Icfem Dreamland Mission Hospital. This partnership paves the way for APT devices to be locally available to children in western Kenya for the very first time.

Having trained their therapist, they will now be able to assess and measure children at their centre and forward the measurements to our team to make the devices. Once the devices are made and sent to them, they will distribute them to the child. This will drastically reduce the need for families to travel hundreds of kilometres to Njoro to access essential equipment.
