JANUARY 2026

The LORD is good to all,

Psalm 145 v9

1st / 2nd We give thanks for God's provision over the last year and for the achievements. Pray that 2026 will be a fruitful year and the Lord will grant us the grace, wisdom and strength to continue serving Him faithfully, and will use us to impact lives. Pray that He will continue revealing His will to us and reminding us of our responsibilities.

3rd / 4th January is an expensive time for caregivers who have children starting school. The uniform, admission fee and lunch fee amount to thousands of Kenyan shillings. With a casual workers daily wage around 300 shillings, caregivers struggle to pay the fees and many children will not be able to attend school. Pray that God would make a way for children living in poverty to get an education and it would not be disrupted by fees charged by schools. Pray for those starting back to school after the long break, that they would settle well and commit themselves fully to their studies.

5th / 6th Pray for the boys that are currently attending the Saturday Club. As their time with us comes to an end, pray that the seed of the Gospel that has been planted will bear fruits resulting in eternal life. Pray for the next group of boys, that the club would positively shape the boys' character and spiritual growth.

7th / 8th Pray for our Men's ministry, that God would go before us and soften the hearts of the men we reach out to and they would be willing to come to meetings. Pray that the Holy Spirit will begin a work in their hearts as they hear God's word explained. Pray those in addiction will have the desire and strength, given by God, to turn away from their current way of life.

9th / 10th Give thanks for us being able to help two caregivers start their own business in December. Pray that God would help their business grow and flourish. Pray that our business trainings and follow-ups would help to bring a long-term impact, accountability and sustainability to families.

11th / 12th Give thanks for the kitchen gardening training that is done every month. Pray that the knowledge and skills acquired will help improve food availability, eating habits and general health of all learners and their family.

13th / 14th Pray for the APT Network event we will be hosting next month. Pray for the safe travel to and from Njoro for participants. Pray that the time together will be a good time of innovation and learning, useful for the progression of APT in Kenya, so that more children can access the equipment they need.

15th / 16th Pray for the children living with disabilities and their caregivers that will attend the play and communication training days. Pray that they will be willing to come and fully participate and that the days would help give them the knowledge and skills to improve their day to day activities and quality of life. Pray that the staff would have wisdom when answering difficult questions and Jesus would be seen in the warm welcome and conversations they have.

17th/18th Pray for a family that has recently separated. It was a violent marriage and the children have witnessed a lot of unhealthy behaviour in the home. Pray God would give the mum and the children protection and help them to heal. Pray that as we continue to meet with the dad and share scripture, God would bring him under conviction and convince him of his need of Christ. We pray for God's will to be done in this situation and there to be love and peace for all.

19th/20th Pray for a new family that has been referred. The granny struggles with alcohol addiction which pushes the 2 grandsons she cares for onto the streets. Pray that she will attend the weekly meetings and by God's grace we would be able to support her out of addiction. Pray for safety for the boys and that they would get the love and stability they need.

21st/22nd Threads of Hope is a ministry in Molo which trains caregivers in sewing. Give thanks that Grace, a member of staff, has the opportunity to learn with them to become a trainer herself. Pray with us as we seek God's guidance when considering to start a sewing training program for caregivers and a Saturday Club

for girls that would teach them basic sewing skills. Pray that God would provide what is needed and He would be glorified through it.

23rd/24th Pray for improvement in a relationship between a teenager and her step dad. Currently there is a lot of friction between the two. This makes the atmosphere in the house difficult for all the children, as well as her Mum. Pray that God would help them learn to love and respect each other. Pray for all families where there is conflict, that God would restore relationships and bring peace and love to homes.

25th/26th Give thanks for the impact our Parent Support Group has on families. Pray that caregivers would continue to come and feel able to share experiences with others. Pray that we would live out the meaning of our new name Jabori (one who brings comfort to people) - comforting them in their affliction with the comfort that we ourselves were comforted by God. 2 Corinthians 1 v4

27th/28th Next month, the team will be joined by husband and wife, Rob and Helen. Rob is a retired engineer and will be working alongside the APT team on new designs. Helen is a retired Occupational Therapist and will be working alongside staff and providing training on disability. Give thanks for their willingness to travel and share their skills and knowledge with others. Pray that the time with them would be helpful to the staff and help improve the services we provide to families. Pray for their safe travel and good health while in Kenya.

29th/30th Give thanks to God for His provision for the charity since it began. Pray that God would lead us to faithful partners and donors who share the vision, and with their support, and by God's grace, we would be able to continue and expand the ongoing activities.

31st Pray for wisdom, sensitivity and safety for staff as they conduct home visits. Pray that they will be able to build good relationships with families that help bring about emotional, spiritual and economic transformation.
